Public Comment Period for Water Commission Irrigation Cost-Share

BISMARCK - The State Water Commission (SWC) is taking public comments related to the irrigation project cost-share percentage in existing Cost-Share Program policy. Current policy provides for up to 50 percent cost-share on projects associated with off-farm central supply works that are sponsored by eligible political subdivisions.

Public comments will be collected over a 14-day comment period from June 23 - July 6, 2023. For specific policy language see <u>https://www.dwr.nd.gov/pdfs/cost_share_policy.pdf</u>.

The SWC also provides support to the Bank of North Dakota's (BND) Ag PACE program to assist individual producers with loan interest buy-down related to on-farm irrigation development. The primary purpose of the Cost-Share Program is to assist local project sponsors with financial support for water development projects – making them more affordable to local constituents.

The 10-member SWC consists of Gov. Doug Burgum as chairman, Ag. Commissioner Doug Goehring and eight members appointed by the governor to serve six-year terms.
