INTRODUCTION

In this Supplement "A" is included a compilation of all the Water Right Filings of record in the office of the State Engineer of North Dakota up to November 1, 1944, and continued to June 30, 1950.

These were scattered through many different reports of the State Engineer and State Water Conservation Commission, with no one report covering the full list of Water Right Filings, for distribution to those desiring information. For this reason, this is published as a Supplement to the 7th Biennial Report, for convenience in distribution to inquirers.

APPLICATION FOR WATER RIGHTS

Blanks and instructions for applications for the use of water for irrigation or industrial use can be secured by writing the State Engineer, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota.

Lands to be irrigated must be surveyed, certified by a responsible engineer and mapped in duplicate, which must accompany the application, accompanied by a filing fee of \$5.00.

If approved, a Notice of Hearing must be published for four consecutive weeks in the official county newspaper at the expense of the applicant. The public hearing is held in the office of the State Engineer, at which time any objections to the application can be made.

If the State Engineer recommends the granting of a permit, it must be approved by the State Water Conservation Commission.

Required construction work must be completed within a reasonable time and beneficial use made of the water for which application was made.

If no beneficial use is made of the water for a period of three years, the Water Right may be revoked by the State Engineer as provided by law.
