North Dakota State Water Commission

December 5, 1975

The North Dakota State Water Commission held a meeting at the Ramada Inn in Minot, North Dakota, on December 5, 1975. Governor-Chairman, Arthur A. Link, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., and requested Secretary Fahy to present the agenda to the Commission members.

CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 19, 1975 MEETING

CONSIDERATION OF BELMONT FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT, GRAND FORKS (SWC Project No. 1105) The minutes of the November 19, 1975 Commission meeting were distributed, but not approved, pending review by the Commission members.

Secretary Fahy referred to the request for financial assistance in the amount of \$110,000 made at the September 29-30, 1975 meeting to build a flood control project in

Grand Forks. He then introduced Mr. Art Thoraldson, Chairman, of the Grand Forks County Water Management District, who in turn updated the Commission members on actions taken by the City of Grand Forks relative to assessing property owners for part of the project finances. Questions and discussions involving assessments did not satisfy the Commission members, therefore, Secretary Fahy was asked to further study the assessment apportionment and report at the next Commission meeting.

DISCUSSION REGARDING SETTING LAKE LEVEL FOR SPIRITWOOD LAKE, STUTSMAN COUNTY (SWC Project No. 461) Secretary Fahy reviewed actions taken in the controversy over flood control elevations at Spiritwood Lake and informed the Commission members of the considerations made in developing criteria to establish a tentative

lake level elevation of 1442 feet above sea level. He further discussed the problems to be solved before an outlet can be established. He explained that protection must be provided to eliminate any possibility of release of grass-eating carp to downstream waters.

CONSIDERATION IN SETTING
DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING

(SWC Water Permit No. 2179)

Secretary Fahy reminded the Commission members of their decision at the last meeting to set a hearing date for a water permit application filed by Basin Electric Power Cooperative for industrial water near Renner Bay in Mercer County. After some discussion, the date was set for January 20, 1976,

at 10:00 a.m., Mountain Standard Time, Hazen, North Dakota. It was also decided to have a business meeting in Bismarck the following day, January 21, 1976.

CONSIDERATION OF REQUEST BY CITY OF UNDERWOOD FOR GROUND-WATER STUDY (SWC Project No. 1290) Action was deferred until a proposal can be worked out by staff.

CONSIDERATION OF WATER PERMIT REQUESTS

Secretary Fahy presented APPENDIX "A" attached hereto, which represents water permit requests. He indicated

that his staff has reviewed each application and has made recommendations

noted on the attachment. It was his recommendation that the Commission approve those requests as indicated, and defer those requests recommended for further study and information.

After discussion and the Commission reviewed those requests for a water permit listed on APPENDIX "A", it was moved by Commissioner Lanz, seconded by Commissioner Wilhelm, and carried, that the Commission approve the following water permit requests, subject to the conditions indicated on the respective application: No. 2282 - John R. It was moved by Commissioner Lanz, seconded by Commissioner Wilhelm, and

carried, that permit No. 2271 - Fred Dohrmann, Taylor, be denied, as it was the Commission's feelings that the availability of water is inadequate in the particular area of the applicant's request.

It was also moved by Commissioner Lanz, seconded by Commissioner Wilhelm, and carried, that the Commission defer action at this time on the following water permit requests pending additional information and study:

CAVALIER COUNTY DRAINAGE (SWC Project No. 1098)

Alan Grindberg, an attorney for a farmer-client in Cavalier County, made a request to have either the

local water management district or the State Water Commission enforce the drainage resolution and statutes relative to alleged illegal drainage in the area of Rush Lake in Cavalier County. A lengthy discussion followed. Secretary Fahy assured the Commission members that he and his staff were attempting to work with present statutes and resolution, but noted that the problem may have to be solved by legal action of local officials or through civil complaints which might be filed by the state against the offenders. The State Engineer was requested to send a letter to a number of property owners in the county advising them against further drainage without proper permits and informing them that action is being considered, which could force closing of some illegal drains.

WATER MARKETING TO INDUSTRIAL USERS BY BUREAU OF RECLAMATION (SWC Project No. 1494) Secretary Fahy called on Murray Sagsveen to review staff discussions with the Bureau of Reclamation to ensure the inclusion of provisions favorable to the state in a water

service contract between American Natural Gas Company and the Bureau of Reclamation. The contract will be reviewed by Commission members prior to the next meeting.

Governor Link left the meeting at noon to attend a funeral at Arnegard. The Commission members adjourned for lunch and reconvened at 1:30 for miscellaneous discussions relative to possible conditions to be attached to conditional industrial water permits for energy conversion facilities.

Commissioner Kramer requested some basic information on water charges for a starting point in ensuing discussions.

At 2:30 p.m., Commissioner Kramer moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gray and was carried.
