# North Dakota State Water Commission Killdeer, North Dakota

#### February 11, 1983

The North Dakota State Water Commission held a meeting at the School Gymnasium, Killdeer, North Dakota, on February 11, 1983. Governor-Chairman, Allen I. Olson, called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m., Mountain Standard Time, and requested Secretary, Vernon Fahy, to present the agenda.

CONTINUED DISCUSSION OF THE NOKOTA COMPANY APPLICATION FOR A WATER PERMIT FOR INDUSTRIAL USE (SWC Water Permit No. 3508)

Secretary Fahy presented The Nokota Company's application item, which had been earlier announced as the only agenda item that would be considered other than the minutes of the previous meeting.

Secretary Fahy made known the official application, which was filed with him as the State Engineer on November 17, 1981, and further noted other items now filed with the application in the form of the transcript of hearing, hearing letters and petitions, and the Company's Environmental Assessment.

Secretary Fahy called on Mr. Galen Andersen, President of The Nokota Company, to present the applicant's review on the permit filing. Mr. Andersen then introduced Attorney Lawrence Klemin, who summarized the permit progress since the original hearing date of June 18, 1982.

Following Mr. Klemin was Leslie Young, who presented the socio-economic environmental assessment.

Following Mr. Cichy's presentation of the proposed conditions to be incorporated in a contract if the permit is approved, Mr. Lawrence Klemin, Attorney for The Nokota Company, presented oral arguments in which he outlined Nokota Company's specific objections to a number of the proposed conditions.

It was suggested, and it was agreed to by the Commission members, that action be postponed at this time on the water permit application filed by The Nokota Company and that objections of Nokota Company be submitted in writing for State Water Commission consideration.
