## May 28, 1986

The North Dakota State Water Commission held a meeting on May 28, 1986, in the Eagles Lodge at Valley City, North Dakota. Governor-Chairman, George A. Sinner, called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m., and requested State Engineer and Secretary, Vernon Fahy, to present the agenda.

Also discussed was a proposal by the Upper Sheyenne River Joint Water Resource District to construct a flood storage works on Baldhill Creek, tributary to the main reservpir.

Petitions were filed by the Association for Preservation of the Sheyenne River Valley, numbering 1,115 signatures, opposed to the raising of Baldhill Dam. The address of almost all of the signers appears to be in an area near or adjacent to the Sheyenne River Valley along the reach from Cooperstown and Valley City.
