North Dakota State Water Commission Telephone Conference Call Meeting Bismarck, North Dakota

February 17, 1994

The North Dakota State Water Commission held a telephone conference call meeting in the Governor's Conference Room, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota, on February 17, 1994. Chairman, Governor Edward T. Schafer, called the meeting to order at 1:30 PM, and requested State Engineer and Chief Engineer-Secretary, David Sprynczynatyk, to call the roll. CONSIDERATION OF AGENDA

There being no additional items for the agenda, the Chairman declared the agenda approved and requested Secretary Sprynczynatyk to present the agenda.

SOUTHWEST PIPELINE PROJECT CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF
AWARD OF CONTRACT 7-1B TO
MAINLINE CONSTRUCTION, INC.,
BILLINGS, MT
(SWC Project No. 1736)

Tim Fay, Manager of the Southwest Pipeline Project, stated that bids were opened for Contract 7-1B on January 27, 1994. This contract involves the installation of approximately 300 miles of rural water service lines.

A total of six bids were received. The apparent low bid was from Mainline Construction, Inc., Billings, Montana, for \$4,929,765.90.

Mr. Fay stated that although Mainline Construction does not appear to have much experience in this type of construction, their bid is responsive and responsible. Conversations with owners and engineers who have worked with them in the past indicate they are capable of successfully completing Contract 7-1B.

Secretary Sprynczynatyk explained the North Dakota Century Code relating to preference for North Dakota bidders and employment when a project involves only state funds. He said that when a project involves the expenditure of federal funds, it is necessary to comply with the federal requirement that all bidders are treated equally and that no state preference be given. Secretary Sprynczynatyk stated that Garrison MR&I Water Supply Program federal funds will be used for Southwest Pipeline Project Contract 7-1B and, therefore, state preference cannot be considered.

It was the recommendation of the State Engineer that the State Water Commission approve the award of Southwest Pipeline Project Contract 7-1B to Mainline Construction, Inc., Billings, Montana.

It was moved by Commissioner Swenson and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the State Water Commission approve the award of Southwest Pipeline Project Contract 7-1B to Mainline Construction, Inc., Billings, Montana.

Commissioners Ames, Bjornson, Olin, Swenson, Thompson, Cathy Reagan for Commissioner Vogel, and Chairman Schafer voted aye. There were no nay votes. The Chairman declared the motion unanimously carried.

CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO EUGENE D. "SACK" SACKMAN (SWC Resolution No. 94-2-463) The Commission members considered a draft resolution of appreciation to Eugene D. "Sack" Sackman. Mr. Sackman is retiring as an employee of the

State Water Commission staff on February 28, 1994, after 37 years of service to the state.

It was moved by Commissioner Olin, seconded by Commissioner Ames, and unanimously carried, that the State Water Commission approve Resolution No. 94-2-463, In Appreciation to Eugene D. "Sack" Sackman. (SEE APPENDIX "A")

There being no further business to come before the State Water Commission, it was moved by Commissioner Olin, seconded by Commissioner Bjornson, and unanimously carried, that the State Water Commission telephone conference call meeting adjourn at 1:50 PM.


